

DOC ANDERSON'S TRAVELING INDIAN MEDICINE SHOW. . .

. . . is an attraction, not just an act.

Complete with it's own stage, colorfully decorated with circus-like banners, and a quaint antique-style horse-drawn wagon (*no horses are used*) - **this attraction can be seen from several blocks away**, or clear across most fairgrounds. **It draws people to the shows, so you get lots of happy event-goers.** And, it helps to make your event look bigger and better.

The performances are done in the character of the old-time Snake Oil Salesman. There is a humorous "sales pitch" for a mythical product called *Doc Anderson's Swamp Oil Elixir*. The "sales pitch" includes magic tricks that are tongue-in-cheek demonstrations of the effectiveness of the Swamp Oil Elixir. **There is lots of audience participation** as kids help with the magic tricks during Doc Anderson's three shows each day.

And because many people don't know the real history behind traveling medicine shows, Doc Anderson starts out with a short talk about traveling medicine shows before the performance begins. **That lets you refer to the attraction as educational as well as entertaining.**

Doc Anderson's Traveling Indian Medicine Show is an attraction that will save you money.

You would have to hire several different entertainers to equal the entertainment variety offered in Doc Anderson's performances. The attraction includes:

- Amazing and hilarious magic tricks - *you get good, family-style entertainment.*
- See the strange thing! - *a sensational circus sideshow-style crowd pleaser.*
- Cowboy Cons and Swindles - **Doc Anderson doesn't vanish between shows.** *He delights your event goers with demonstrations of Old West Swindles like the Three Shell Game and "crooked poker dealing."*
- Colorful balloon sculptures - *kids love 'em!*
- Audience participation - kids love being part of the show. Parents love the happy faces. *You get happy event goers.*
- Lots of corny jokes - the kind that leave audiences groaning with glee and *remembering your event with total delight.*
